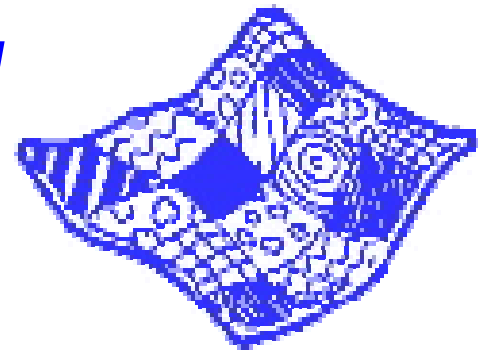


# Do What's Right!

## Supply List

To make this mystery, you will need...

- ♦ A sense of adventure, for you will be venturing into unknown territory!
- ♦ Access to the internet, for that's the only place you'll be able to access all the clues you'll need to solve the mystery and complete your quilt!

And you'll need eight fabrics total:

One is the background... This has to be lighter or darker than ALL your other fabrics. It must provide contrast with all your other fabrics.

Then you'll need 3 fabrics of the same color family and close in value. That's the Color A Group and...

Three fabrics in a complimentary or contrasting color family, again all close in value. These are the Color B Group.

The C Group is just one fabric...that must be the combination of Color A and Color B. So let's say you choose blue for your first color A. And all your A fabrics are a soft blue value. Your second color B could be pink. That would make your C color a sort of light purple or lavender. It's important that your A and B colors blend to make C.

## So here's what you need:

	<b>Small Quilt</b>	<b>Large Quilt</b>
Background	3 yards	4 yards
Color A Fabric 1	3 1/4 yards	3 1/2 yards
Color A Fabric 2	1/2 yard	3/4 yard
Color A Fabric 3	1/2 yard	3/4 yard
Color B Fabric 1	3/4 yard	1 yard
Color B Fabric 2	1/2 yard	3/4 yard
Color B Fabric 3	1/2 yard	3/4 yard
Color C Fabric 1	3/8 yard	1/2 yard

This quilt is based on a very traditional quilt pattern, but made in a totally different way!
