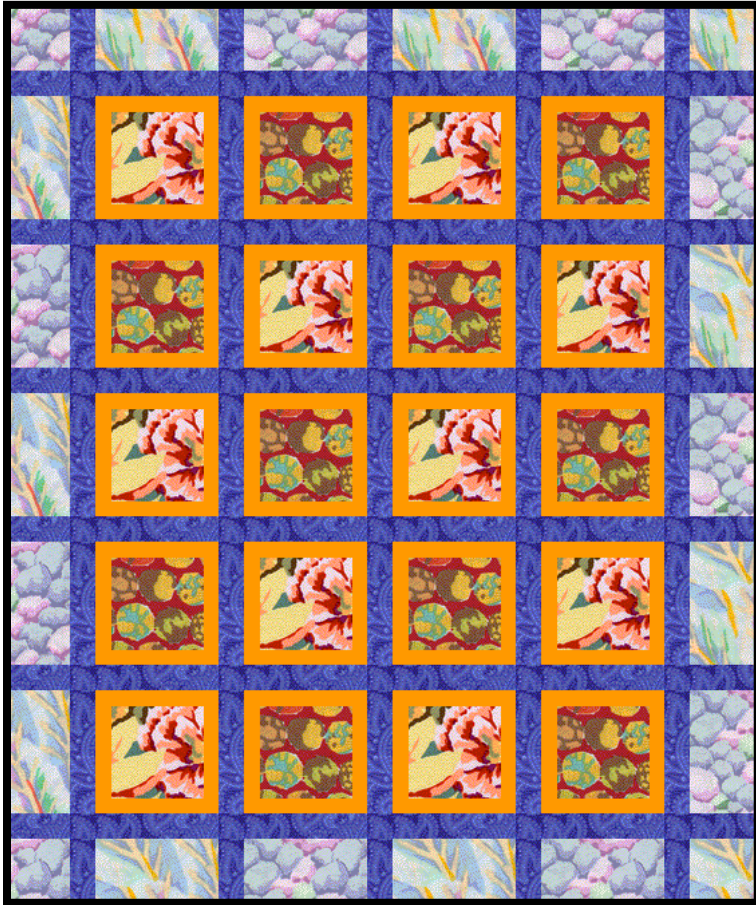
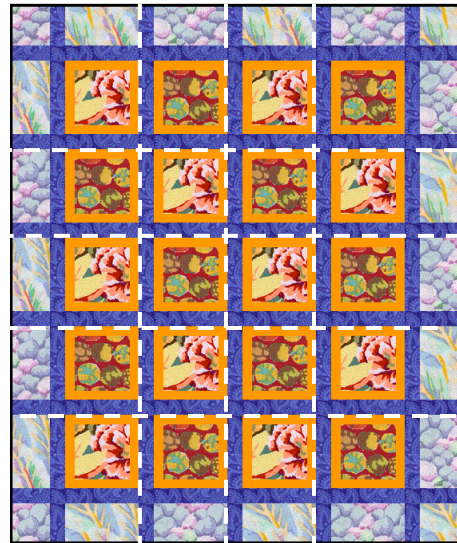


Getting the Basic Border on Blocks technique Block To Block Quilts

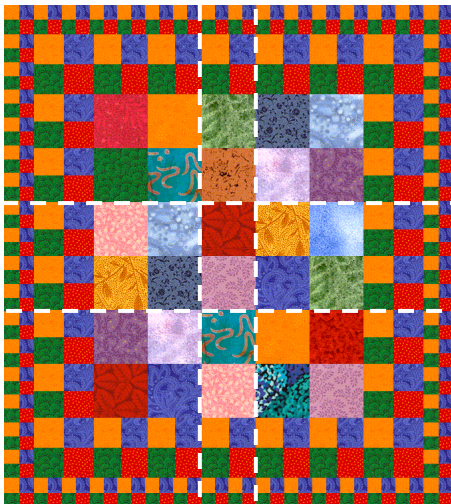

This very quick quilt is a splendid rendition of the Borders On Blocks Technique.

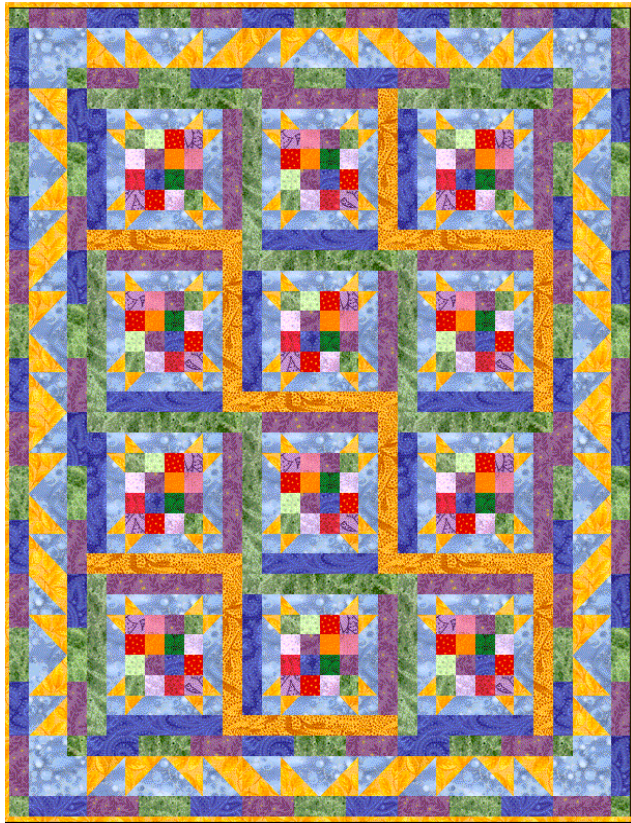

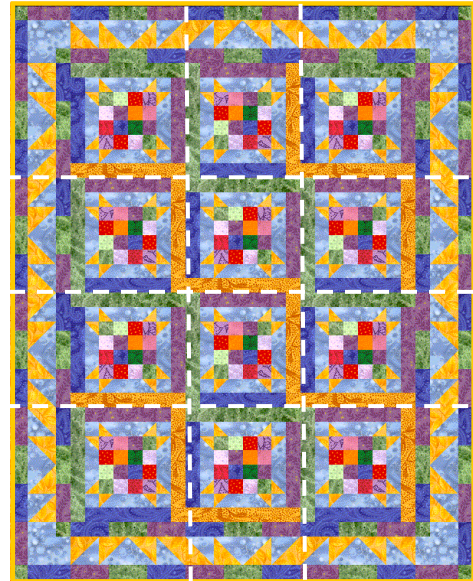


Block Quilts

then the Border Blocks are added

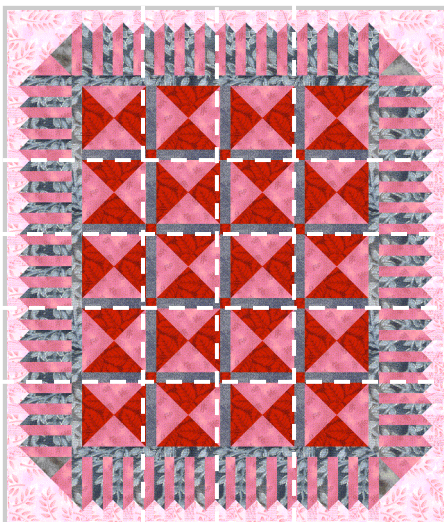


Cruzin' Around (65 X 81)

with the BoB technique.

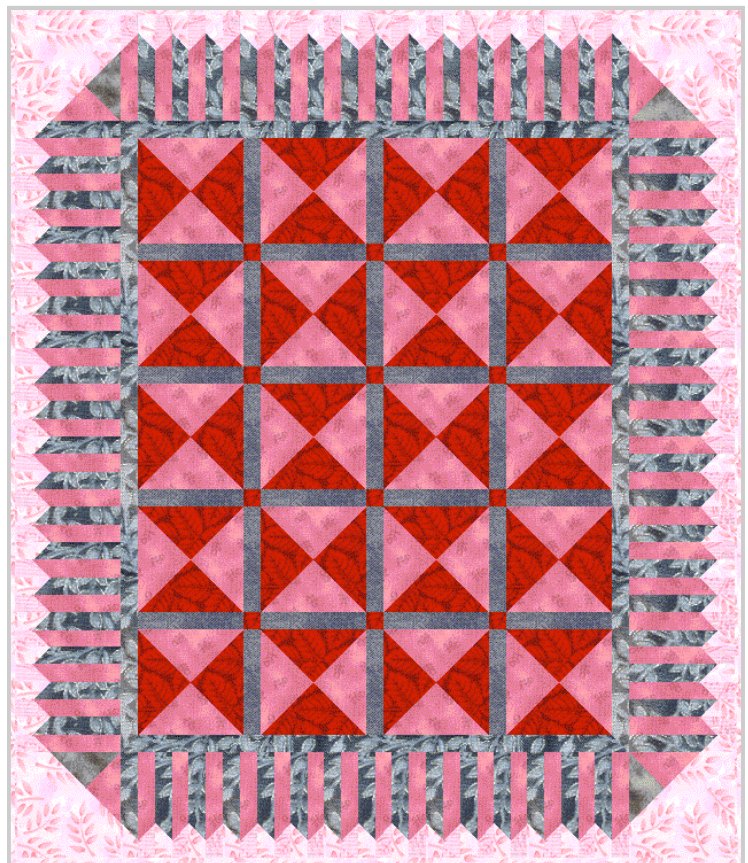

into the Border.

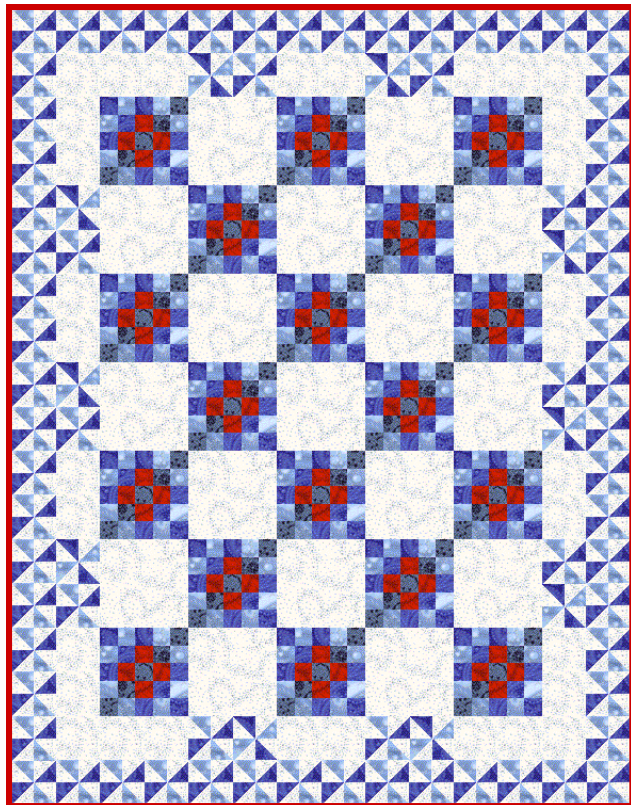

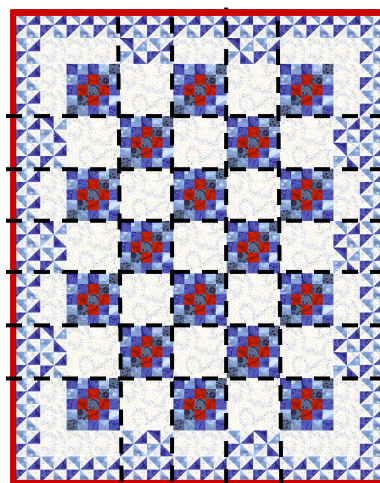
More Block Quilts

Alternate Block and Strippy Quilts can also benefit from the Border On Blocks Technique



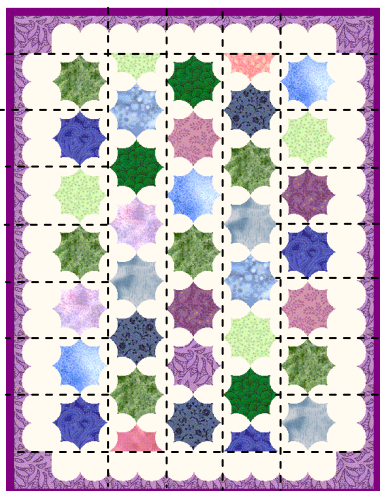
Patches And Pinwheels (71 X 91)

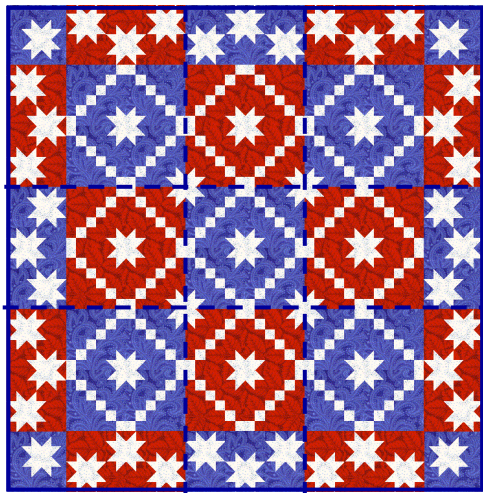


Great Block Quilts

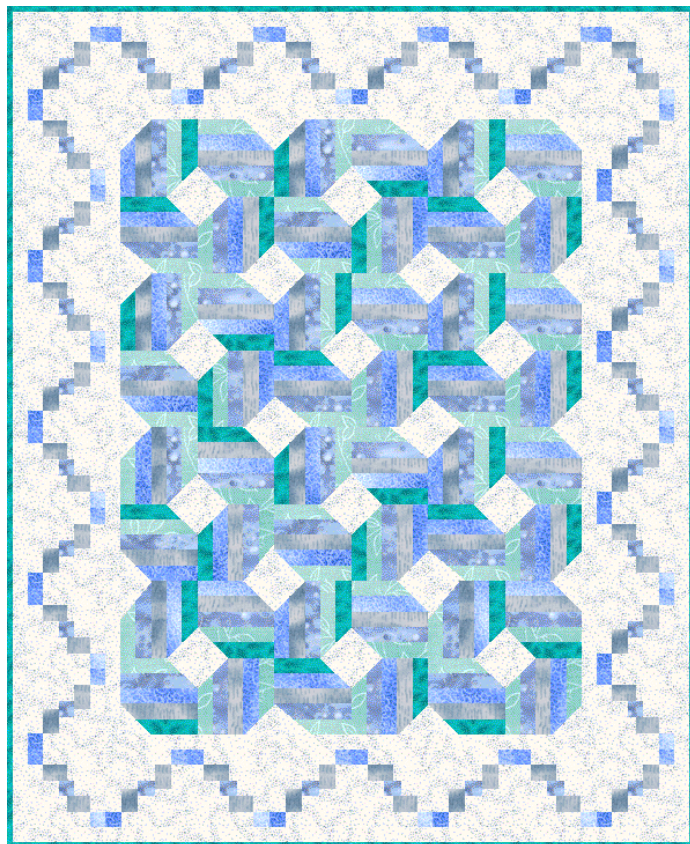
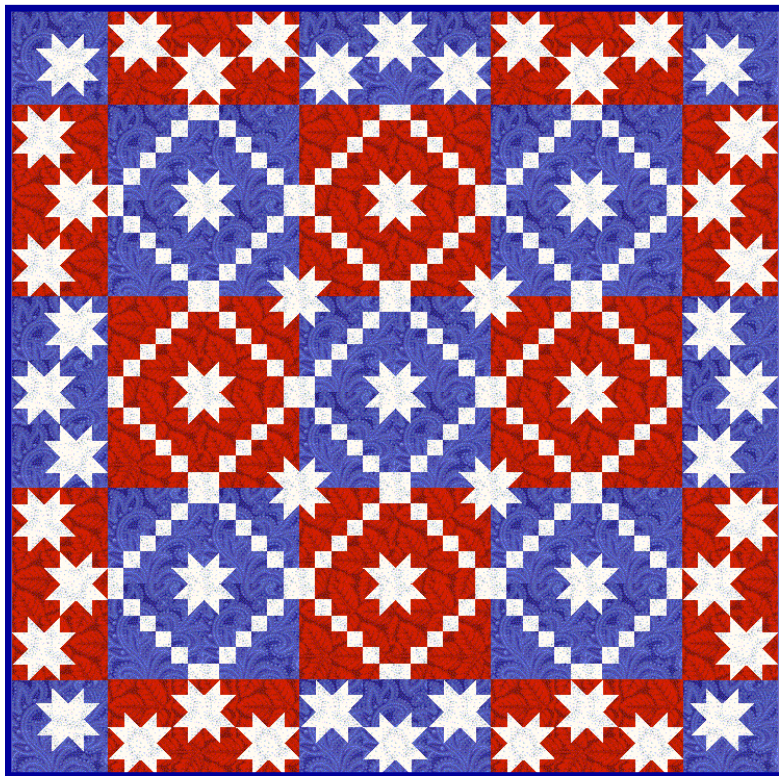
Combining smaller blocks into Great Blocks

Chains Of Friendship (96 X 96)

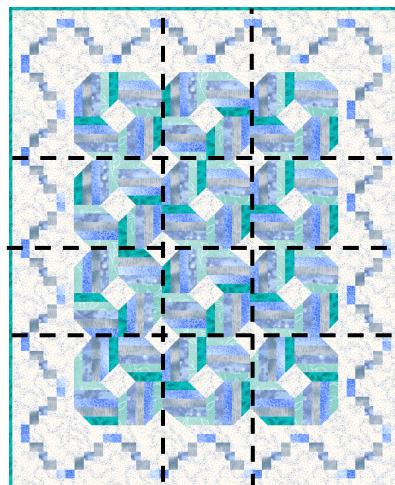
Two kinds of simple chains combine in great blocks then the Bouncing Triple Star border blocks complete the design.

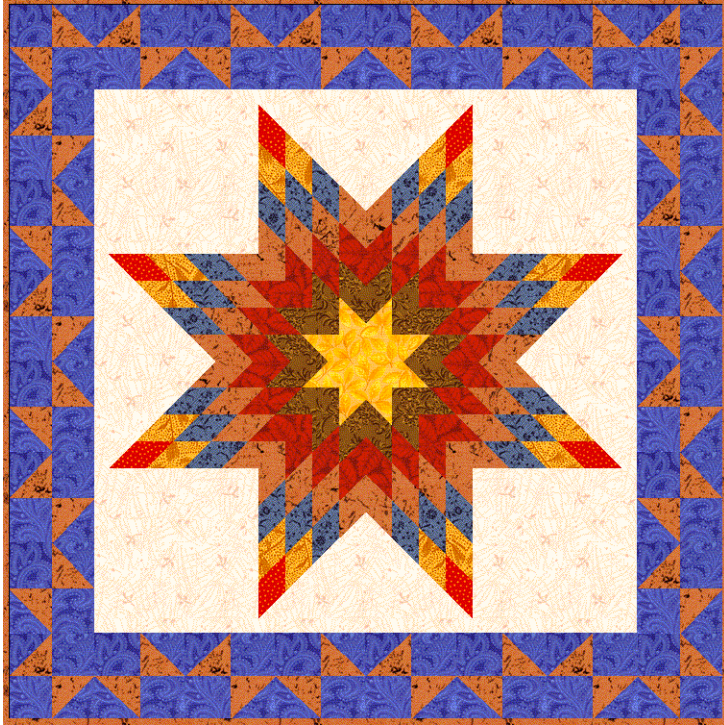
Moondance (67 X 82)

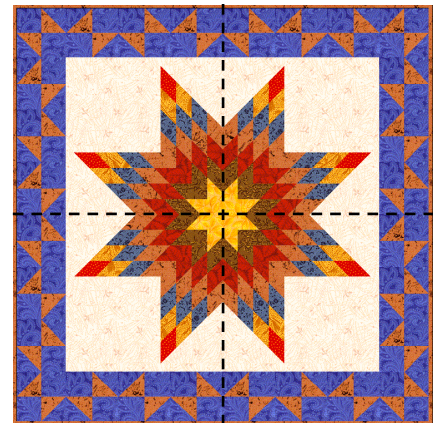
Quadrant Quilts

This **Solar Power Lone Star** (48 X 48)
is made from a collection of 2 1/2"
Strips or a Jelly Roll.

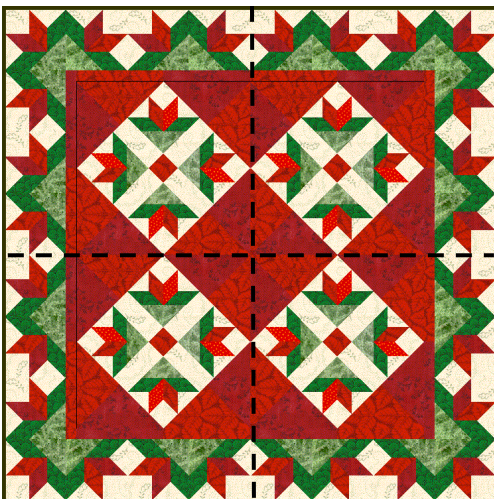
The Background triangles and

tion. This allows the borders to be
assembled with each quadrant.



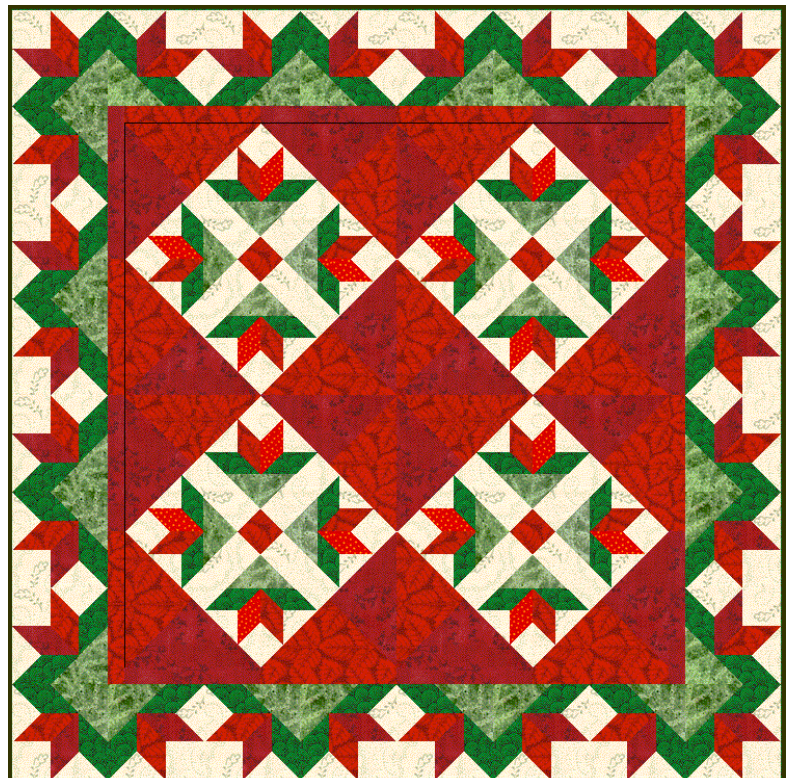

allows the BoB technique to shine.

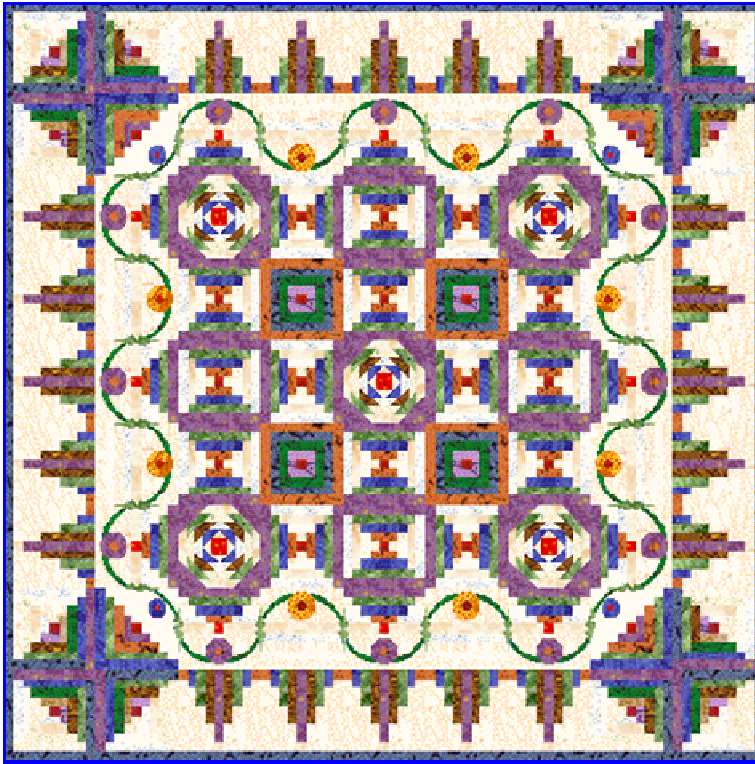

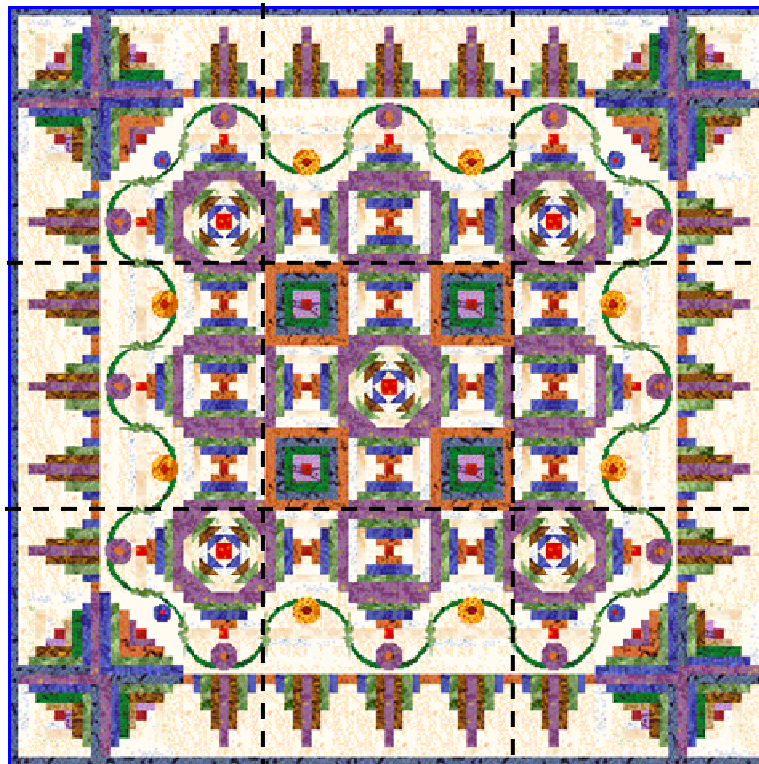
Multiple Block Quilt
